**FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL** – The first day of the 2011-2012 school year for grades K-6 will be Monday, August 29<sup>th</sup>. Students in 4K will start on Tuesday, August 30<sup>th</sup>. Please note that we will not have bus service for the first three days of school. This means that parents will be responsible for getting their children to and from school these days. Regular bus service will begin on Thursday, September 1<sup>st</sup> when the public school begins classes.

**DROP-OFF / PICK-UP PROCEDURES** – Those who will be dropping their children off at school in the morning are asked to enter the back playground area from Cherry Street, drop their children off by the yellow slide, and exit onto Maple Street. If you need to park, please park on the West side of the parking lot by Best Western and walk your children into school using the playground entrance. Please refrain from dropping children off at the front entrance of the school as this area is reserved for buses each morning. After school, parents are asked to pick children up at the front entrance of school. Please refrain from using the back playground area as this area will be reserved for the bus each afternoon. There is one bus that picks up all bus riders from Saint Clement and takes them to Winskill where they will get on the bus that will take them home. Some teachers will ride the bus (starting Thursday, August 1<sup>st</sup>) to make sure all students understand the proper procedures. Again, please feel free to call the school anytime you have questions or concerns.

**SCHOOL PICTURES** – Life Touch Photography will be taking pictures of all students and staff immediately following Mass on **Wednesday, September 7<sup>th</sup>**. If any parents would like pictures taken of younger children, please bring them to school around 8:40 a.m. Order forms will be sent home during the first week of school. Please look for these forms and make sure they are returned to school with money before the day of pictures.

At this session we will learn the steps that can be taken by parishes and by adults that can help reduce the incidence of child sexual abuse in society, and what can be done by us to protect the children entrusted to our care.

We have scheduled a PGC awareness session at the parish on Tuesday, September 20<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 p.m. in the rectory basement. If you have not attended one of these sessions in the past and you volunteer with our kids in any way, such as a chaperone, tutor, centers helper, substitute teacher, playground duty, etc. you do need to attend one of these very important and pertinent informational sessions.

- Click on “begin registration process”
- From the pull-down menu, choose “Madison, WI (Diocese)
- then continue the registration process with your information
- Finally, select the PGC Awareness Session here at St. Clement on September 20<sup>th</sup>.

Pre-registration is required. If you have questions, or do not have internet access, call me at 723-4990 or stop at my office and I can help get you signed-up. If you cannot make this session, you can find other session offerings held in our area when you scroll down the location choices at the site above. Again, thank you for helping out in our efforts in handing on faith and knowledge to our children. We literally couldn't do it without you!
