Track Meet – Congratulations to the Saint Clement School Track Team on an outstanding performance at this year's MRVPL Track Meet at Platteville. Thank you to Head Coach Mr. Leibfried and Assistant Coach Mrs. Hentrich for preparing the 5th and 6th grade students to perform at such high levels. There were many strong performances and personal bests in this meet including: Austin Mumm – 1st Place in the High Jump (4' 2"), 1st Place in the 200M Run (33:38), and 1st Place in the 400M (1:12:84), Mallory Bahl – 1st Place in the High Jump (3' 10"), and Jacob Ihm – 1st Place in the Shot Put (26' 3"). Also Eden Connelly, Annalise Hauk, Jessica Miles, and Mallory Bahl – 1st Place in the 400M Relay (1:09) and Josh Hentrich, Anthony Pozorski, Shawn Zenz, and Austin Mumm – 1st place in the 400M Relay (1:09). We also greatly appreciate the volunteer help from Sue McLean and Kay Hoffman in helping run the discus competition at this meet.

Ecology Meet – Congratulations to Dalton Gardner, Brandon Hoffman, Austin Mumm, Evan Straka and Elizabeth Walker for represented Saint Clement School at this year's Eco-Meet Competition at Eagle Point Park in Dubuque. These students earned 2nd place out of 29 schools in this competition which helps teach students more about the world we live in. This is the best finish ever by a team from Saint Clement School in the history of this competition and there is a shiny new trophy on display in our trophy case. Congratulations once again to these students and thank you for representing our school so well!

DVD's Available – Please contact the school if you would still like to purchase a DVD of this year's music program, "GPS: God's Plan of Salvation." We have a limited supply available in the office and could burn more if needed.

Operating Costs – Just a reminder, we are looking at raising tuition starting with the 2012-2013 school year. Saint Clement Parish currently covers 65% of all the operating costs of our wonderful school. This leaves 35% for the school to cover through tuition and fund raising. School expenses for the upcoming school year are projected to be \$496,175 or about \$4,315 per child. As you can see, this is significantly less than the \$1,050 we charge for tuition. As contributions to our parish continue to decline, it has become increasingly difficult to make ends meet. Therefore, starting this fall, the school will have to be responsible for 38% of the operating costs or \$188,547 leaving 62% of the operating costs or \$307,629 for the parish to graciously cover. Past fundraising successes have allowed us to delay tuition increases through this coming school year. However, we will have to start raising more money through tuition and fundraising in the coming years to ensure the continued success of our great parish and school. This is also a wonderful time to reflect on our current church contributions and consider signing up for electronic giving. Thank you for your support of our great parish and school!

Boxtops for Education and Campbell's Soup Label – Sister Eva and the 6th grade class have just finished sorting and counting all the box tops and labels you have turned in throughout the second half of the school year. We collected 7,818 Campbell's Soup labels and 2,583 Boxtops worth **\$389.30** which will be applied towards our new classroom projectors and interactive whiteboards. Technology Updates – You may have heard your children talking about Mobi’s or seen them in action during the curriculum fair. They are a mobile interactive whiteboard similar to “Smartboards” and are revolutionizing teaching and student learning. We have been sampling two of them in our classrooms during the fourth quarter and students and teachers have absolutely loved them. Therefore we have asked for and received a quote to install permanently fixed projectors in each classroom with the Mobi mobile interactive whiteboards. This project will cost about \$16,000 to complete this summer. We have applied for grants to help offset these costs and have received some generous donations already. Donations have ranged from the \$55 raised by the Winter children at their lemonade stand to the \$2,350 anonymous donation to complete one whole classroom.
